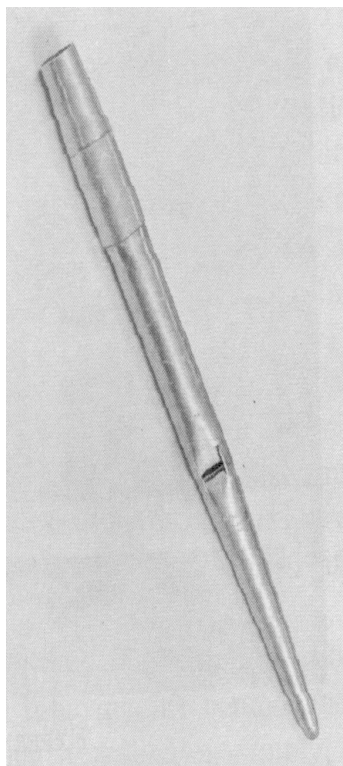

Obituary: Margaret Wold Sihler Anderson, Ph.D., 1935-2006

Margaret Wold Sihler Anderson, Ph.D., child of God, lived a life of faith with her family and in her professional pursuits. She began the study of piano and organ as a child. At age 10, barely able to reach the pedals, she pumped the organ to play for services at the Indian Mission, Wittenburg, Wisconsin, moving to the organist position in the town's Lutheran Church at age 14. While in college, Margaret served as substitute organist in churches and at the college chapel. During the years, 1958-1995, she held Director of Music and Organist positions in churches in Minneapolis and Cleveland.

Margaret's professional life as a church musician encompassed many dimensions: parish organist and choir director; national, regional and local leader in the American Guild of Organists and the Association of Lutheran Church Musicians; and conductor of choirs and instrumental ensembles. From 1975-1980, she served as Dean of the Twin Cities (MN) AGO Chapter; 1982-1991, Chairperson, National AGO Convention Committee; 1984-1992, Coordinator for Professional Concerns, Region V; 1977-1980, Program Chairperson, 1980 National AGO Convention, Minneapolis-St. Paul; 1974-75, Program Chairperson, 1975 Region VI AGO Convention, Minneapolis-St. Paul; 1985-88 and 1990-93, Executive Board, Cleveland (OH) AGO Chapter. Margaret was one of the founding/organizing members in the 1980s of the Association of

Lutheran Church Musicians (ALCM). In 1985-86, she served as the Program Chairperson for the 1986 ALCM Constituting Convention, Northfield, MN, and as the Director for Professional Concerns of the ALCM during 1986-88.

For 26 years, 1958-1984, Margaret was the Director of Music and Organist at University Lutheran Church of Hope, Minneapolis. She was the Director of Music for the Roman Catholic Archdiocese of St. Paul and Minneapolis, 1981-84; this was an administrative position with some organist and choral conducting responsibilities. Upon moving to Cleveland for her husband's profession, Margaret was the Director of Music and Organist at Epworth-Euclid United Methodist Church, Cleveland, 1987-1991, and Organist at St. Philomena Roman Catholic Church, Cleveland, 1991-95. As Parkinson's Disease progressed in her body, ultimately ending her life, she could no longer continue her profession as an organist.

In 1979, Margaret was on the national training team introducing the new *Lutheran Book of Worship* to clergy, church musicians and lay leaders throughout the US. Margaret was the organist for several church-wide conventions, national music conferences, and church music and liturgical institutes, including the Lutheran World Federation Conference on Women and Worship (Worship Leader and Organist), 1975; provided worship consultation to the American Lutheran Church in the 1980s; planned and directed the 1980 International Conference on the Arts and People with Disabilities; and served as Organ Faculty at the InterLutheran Conferences on Worship, 1982 and 1985. Margaret was one of four Directors conducting the premier choral works of Darius Milhaud at the International Milhaud Festival, 1991. In addition, she was a college and university teacher, a recitalist, and publisher of parish music materials and professional papers and monographs.

Margaret was the daughter of Lutheran missionary parents, Rev. Ernest and Mabel Wold Sihler, who worked with Native Americans in Wisconsin during the years of her childhood and youth. Her grandfather, Dr. William Sihler, was a professor at Luther College, Decorah, Iowa for 50 years. Her great-grandfather, Dr. Wilhelm Sihler, was one of the co-founders of the Lutheran Church—Missouri Synod. Margaret's maternal grandfather, Dr. Oscar R. Wold, was the first President of the Lutheran Church in China and the President of the first Lutheran Seminary in China.

Her formal education included the B.A. degree from Luther College and the M.A. and Ph.D. degrees from the University of Minnesota. In 1992, she was awarded the Distinguished Service Award by Luther College *for the music she provides in church, and for her continuing work to define the church organist as a disciplined professional in the service of God and the people of God.*

As wife and mother, Margaret provided a nurturing home for her children and husband. Her sudden and untimely death May 10, 2005 leaves a profound void in the family. She is survived by her husband, Rev. Kenneth J. Anderson, Cleveland; two daughters, Nadia Anderson (fiance, Jon Dunmow) Ames IA, and Elena Anderson (husband, Alex Kravitz), Aurora CO; two sisters, Susan Sihler (husband, Dr. Robert Phillips), Asheville NC, and Carolyn Connors (husband, John), Indianapolis IN; and extended family throughout the US.

Dr. Margaret Wold Sihler Anderson was a woman of faith, talent, discipline, and love. She felt the presence of the Holy Spirit as she worked to inspire those who worship. She fulfilled a professional vocation to serve the church and she fulfilled a personal faith-filled vocation to serve her family and friends.

Evening Prayer and a Service of Celebration honoring Margaret's life will be **Saturday, July 15, 5:00 pm, University Lutheran Church of Hope, 601 13th Ave SE, Minneapolis**.
