- Photographs of Arthur at age 8 in 1896 and later; also of relatives, friends, homes, and buildings.
- Photocopied article from the *St. Stephen's Messenger*, St. Stephen's Episcopal Church in Sewickley, PA about Arthur Jennings' background. The date is October, 1921.
- An organ catalog, 1947, from M. Witmark & Sons publicizing Arthur's book, *First Elements of Organ Technic* (inside back cover).
- A guest book with signatures of people who attended a reception following a recital that Arthur played on the Northrop Auditorium organ. The occasion was Arthur's retirement from the U. of MN on May 26, 1956.
- Twelve booklets about the Jennings stained glass window dedicated on October 11, 1964 at Plymouth Congregational Church.
- Seven Arthur B. Jennings memorial service programs from Plymouth Congregational Church dated January 24, 1972. Two Sunday bulletins from Plymouth Congregational Church dated January 23, 1972.
- A large sized photograph/postcard of Arthur Jennings at an organ console with an opposite side message: "Plymouth Congregational Church Presents a Tribute to Arthur B. Jennings Marking the Centenary of His Birth." The date is March 6, 1988 and former students performed works which they studied under his tutelage. There's also a clipping— March 6, 1988—from the Minneapolis Star Tribune publicizing the event.
